Job Title: Schools Work Facilitator [Part-time]

Salary: £30,000 per annum, £12,000 pro rata

Hours: 16 hrs per week, 52 weeks per year.
Standard holiday entitlement, plus training and personal development time included
Remote working

Responsible to: Centre Director of Wirral Youth For Christ

Responsible for: Facilitating & enabling the delivery of high quality schools work, via Christian faith education, exploration and evangelism, through working with local Wirral churches and schools.

1. Job Summary:

- Clear and relevant communication of the Christian faith to children & young people through presence, proclamation and discipleship.
- Producing and managing all schools work relevant resources.
- Maintaining and creating new working relationships between schools and local churches.
- Training and related activities to facilitate and enable schools work to take place from local church workers and volunteers
- Wider Wirral Youth For Christ event involvement as appropriate

2. Main Duties

- To produce and maintain a regular program of assemblies, lessons and PULSE sessions for use as appropriate by secondary & primary schools.
- To plan, write and deliver imaginative, engaging lessons, assemblies and PULSE sessions using a wide variety of media to clearly communicate the gospel.
- To recruit and train a team from local churches to deliver schools work across the Wirral.
- To work closely with local churches to ensure delivery of high-quality schools work.
- To keep supporters and local churches fully informed about your work.
- To have a good level of autonomy - planning and organising your own work, setting action plans and meeting deadlines.

3. Other duties

- Attending role-appropriate training and committing to relevant personal and spiritual development, including regular church attendance.
- Undertake other relevant work for, and representing, Wirral Youth For Christ when necessary.
- Help to organise and support Wirral Youth for Christ events for various stakeholders including church leaders, youth workers.
- Attend regular check-in and prayer meetings with other Wirral Youth For Christ staff and volunteers.
- Attend regular supervision sessions with the Centre Director.
